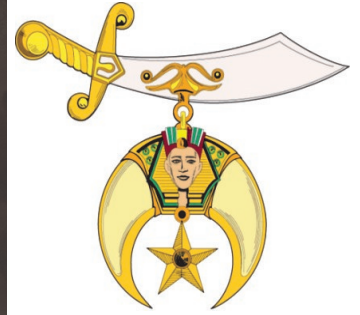

The primary purpose of the publication is to inform all members of the Lake County Shrine Club, about the activities and clubs available for their enjoyment.

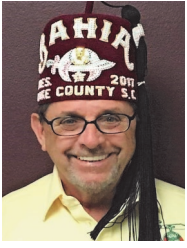

## LAKE COUNTY SHRINE CLUB BAR LICENSE

To dispel all the rumors that are circulating out there concerning the Bar License.

Fact #1 Yes we were audited last year by the state.

Fact #2 We could not produce some documentation that they wanted to see.

Fact #3 We did produce and send down to Orlando some documents.

Fact #4 Unfortunately our response did not satisfy their request.

Fact #5 We received a letter early this month (January) with their findings.

Fact #6 The options are as follows:

A) Pay a \$1,000 fine and relinquish our bar license for a period of 120 days, then reapply for another license.

B) We could appeal the above and request a hearing in Orlando.

Fact #7 With approval from the Board of Directors it was determined to appeal the State's decision.

Fact #8 We continue to operate as normal until we have a definitive answer from our appeal.

We really do not have any idea as to how long it will take to get a hearing date.

As soon as we have a decision on what will happen with the bar license, it will be published.

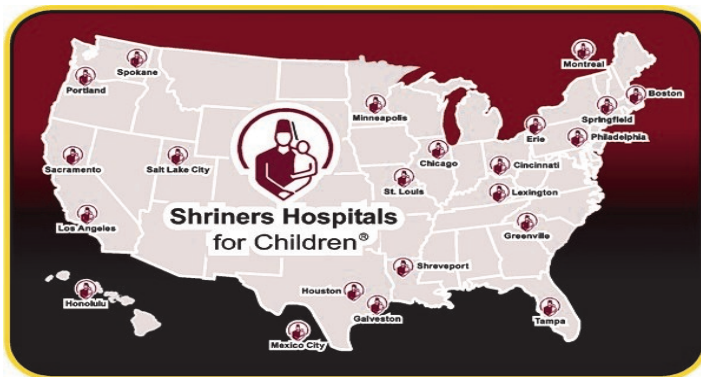

## **A Message from III Sir Jon Thomas Gumina**

### **2016 Bahia Shriners Potentate**

On January 10, 2016, I knew this day would come. Who would have known all the things that transpired this year. We did the customary installation for all the Shrine Clubs and the Widows Club. ## Save Your Pull Tabs to Help Kids

We collect pull tabs at the **Lake County Shrine Club** to recycle them to support the **Shriners Hospitals for Children**. The **Bahia Shriners** have collected over 15 tons of pull tabs, delivered them to our Tampa Hospital, who have raised over \$350,000 to provide transportation to the Shriners' Hospitals. Once the pull tabs are collected, they are sorted to separate the steel tabs, and other materials from the aluminum tabs including change, nuts and bolts, jewelry, pieces of metal, and trash. The remaining pull tabs are recycled at a local scrap yard once the market value of aluminum reaches an optimal price. The other metal tabs and materials are recycled as well but generally are not worth as much per pound as clean aluminum which is what the scrap dealer is looking for because they can sell it directly instead of having to sort it. The funds from "scrapping" are used to fund free transportation to the nearest **Shriners Hospitals for Children** from anywhere in the world for a patient, and his, or her family.

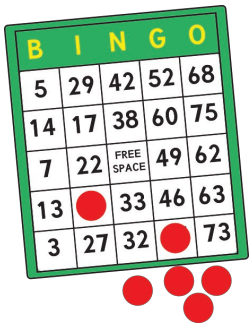

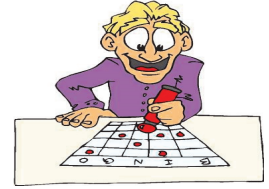

# ADOPT A FLIGHT PROGRAM



Bahia Shriners averages 80 patient treatment flights per year for children who live in Lake, Sumter, Orange, Seminole, Volusia and Osceola counties, to Shriners Hospitals for Children, other than Tampa Hospital each year.

The average cost of a round trip flight for a patient, and an accompanying guardian is **\$500**.

There is never a cost for these flights for the family. They are all funded by the Bahia Transportation Fund.

Children, with severe burn injuries requiring specialized needs, are flown to the Cincinnati Shriners Hospital for Children Burn Unit in ambulatory flights, each with accompanying doctors, nurses, and family members. Each ambulatory flight averages **\$17,500** each. Bahia has had 4 ambulatory flights in 2016.

In order to cover the cost of these expensive patient treatment flights, Bahia Shriners has started an **ADOPT A FLIGHT PROGRAM** for the Transportation Fund.

The way the program works is, Bahia Uniformed Units, Bahia Shrine Clubs, and Bahia Social Clubs, Bahia or Shrine Club Ladies Auxiliary's can adopt a flight for **\$500**. Flights can also be adopted by individual or corporate donations.

Ways to raise money for the program, are by either having an **ADOPT A FLIGHT PROGRAM** fundraiser, by selling \$100 **Paper Crusade Plaques**, or conduct a nonscheduled **Paper Crusade** weekend fund collection. Nothing says you can only collect fund on the first Friday and Saturday of October. The **Paper Crusade Program** is an all year round program.

All contributions collected though the **ADOPT A FLIGHT PROGRAM** will be deposited into the General Transportation Fund Account, and are tax deductible for individuals and corporations.

A running account of adopted flights will appear in the Caravan each month for all to see.

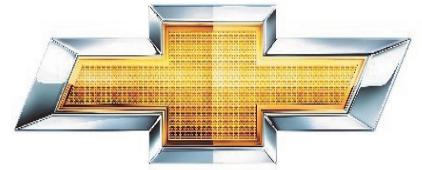
